

## VACCINATION GUIDELINES FOR FOALS

<b>NON-VACCINATED DAM</b>	<b>VACCINATED DAM</b>
<b>3 Months:</b> 3- Way, Rabies, WNV	<b>6 Months:</b> 3-Way, Rabies, Rhino, WNV
<b>4 Months:</b> 3-Way, WNV	<b>7 Months:</b> 3-Way, Rabies, Rhino, WNV
<b>5 Months:</b> 3-Way, Rhino, WNV	<b>8-9 Months:</b> 4-Way, Rhino, WNV
<b>6 Months:</b> Influenza/Rhino	<b>10 Months:</b> Influenza/Rhino
<b>7 Months:</b> Influenza/Rhino	<b>11-12 Months:</b> Rabies, Influenza I/N
<b>8 Months:</b> Influenza I/N	<b>Strangles Injection:</b> 6th, 7th, 8th and 12th month, then every 6 months (may want to use I/N 11th or 12th month).
<b>12 Months:</b> Rabies	<b>Strangles I/N:</b> 11th & 12th month, then every 6 months (start at 6th months for endemic areas).
<b>Strangles Injection:</b> 6th, 7th, 8th and 12th month, then every 6 months (may want to use I/N 11th or 12th month).	<b>3-Way:</b> (E/W Encephalomyelitis, Tetanus Toxoid).
<b>Strangles I/N:</b> 11th & 12th month, then every 6 months (start at 6th months for endemic areas).	<b>4-Way:</b> (E/W Encephalomyelitis, Influenza, Tetanus Toxoid).
<b>3-Way:</b> (E/W Encephalomyelitis, Tetanus Toxoid).	<b>Rhinopneumonitis:</b> (EHV-4 The form of this virus that causes respiratory disease).
<b>Rhinopneumonitis:</b> (EHV-4 The form of this virus that causes respiratory disease).	<b>Equine Herpes Virus:</b>
<b>Equine Herpes Virus:</b>	<b>EHV-1:</b> The form of this virus that primarily causes abortion. Start at 4 months if in high-risk area.
<b>EHV-1:</b> The form of this virus that primarily causes abortion.	<b>EHV-4:</b> Certain strains can cause neurological disease.
<b>EHV-4:</b> Certain strains can cause neurological disease.	<b>De-Worming:</b> Start at 2 months and de-worm every 30 days until 8 months of age. Then continue to de-worm every 60 days. Use Ivermectin, Strongid or Panacur.
<b>De/Worming:</b> Start at 2 months and de-worm every 30 days until 8 months of age. Then continue to de-worm every 60 days. Use Ivermectin, Strongid or Panacur.
